

Dr Orestis Kairis received his BSc degree in agricultural sciences and agricultural engineering (2001), his MSc degree in sustainable soil management (2003), and his PhD degree in land degradation and desertification (2015) from the Agricultural University of Athens (AUA). He has participated as an agricultural engineer or researcher in over 20 EU-funded or financially supported by the Greek State research projects or studies. His experience and expertise are in soil mapping and soil surveying, qualitative and semiquantitative soil suitability evaluation, soil erosion metrics and modelling, and in land degradation and desertification assessment. He has authored/co-authored 18 papers in peer-reviewed journals (Scopus: h index 11, citations 578), a book chapter of an international publishing house and a treatise published by the Academy of Athens. He served as a member of the Greek National Committee for Combating Desertification which was formed in June 2021.
